The Annual Meeting of the Parish Council was held in the Parish Room, Leapsmoor on Thursday, May 27th 1993 at 8pm.

Councillors present were ^{7pm} R. Bury, G. Gregory, G. Gridley, J. Kidd, J. Meller, R. Simpson & A. Wood. The clerk, Mrs A. G. Lloyd also attended.

Mr A. Wood was appointed chairman for the meeting.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read, confirmed and signed.

Arising from the minutes the clerk reported that the reply she had received from the Highways Dept. regarding the problem at Brownsgrill Farm had not been followed by action, so councillors requested that another letter be sent to the appropriate authority.

Mr R. Simpson was elected chairman for the ensuing year having been proposed by Mr J. Meller and seconded by Mr G. Gregory. It was proposed by Mr G. Gregory and seconded by Mr J. Kidd that the vice-chairman be Mr A. Wood. The chairman and vice-chairman are also council delegates.

Mr Wood duly thanked Mr G. E. Gridley (being chairman) for his services. He also requested that the clerk thank the local police for carrying out their duties.

Several items of correspondence were discussed. The council had been invited to send a representative to the inaugural meeting of the recently formed Staff Moorlands Parish Assembly but no councillor indicated willingness to attend.

The clerk had obtained two estimates for the fitting of an outside light to the Parish Room but before these were discussed, Mr G. Gregory reported that a representative from the Peal
